## **DID YOU KNOW?**

**Nearly all (97%) of employers** in the government sector who offer at least one benefit agree that the benefits their company offers enables them to reduce employee turnover – much higher than the **82%** across all industries.

In addition, while **2** in **5** employees (**40%**) nationally rank paid sick time for a COVID-19 diagnosis an important protection at physical worksites, **essentially half (49%) of government sector employees** say the same – illustrating a potential opportunity for employers to enhance employee satisfaction within this sector by offering this type of benefit.
