

EMPLOYEE REALITIES



52% have less than \$1,000 to pay out-of-pocket expenses associated with unexpected serious illnesses or accidents, and **28%** have less than \$500 available.



38% are concerned about maintaining their health care benefits and **30%** are concerned about increasing out-of-pocket medical expenses.



19% have put off a medical procedure longer than they should in the past year.



23% have been to the emergency room and/or suffered an injury in the past year.



21% do not feel¹ fully protected by their insurance coverage.

15% believe their overall benefits packages meet their current family needs extremely well.



13% are extremely satisfied with their overall benefits packages.



12% are dealing with serious health issues.
