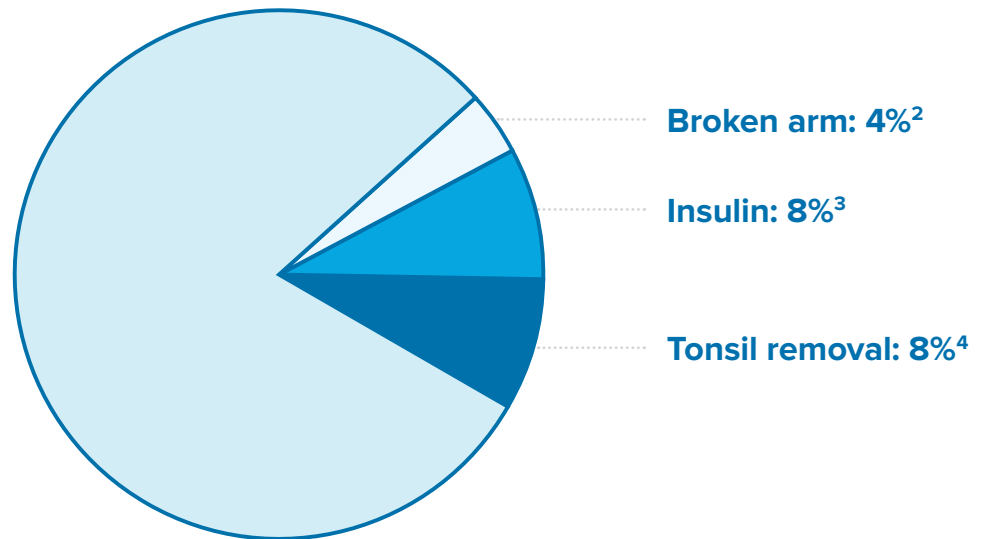


Are your employees prepared?
